

FORTVILLE TOWN COUNCIL MEETING

The Fortville Town Council met Monday, March 1, 2010 at 4:30 p.m. at the Town Hall. The meeting was called to order by President, SEAN SIMMONS. Those present or absent:

A Motion was made by PHIL SCROGHAM to approve the vouchers. Second by TAMMY GILBERT; Motion carried 3-1. (RATLIFF-nay)

A Motion to adjourn the meeting at 5:11p.m. was made by PHIL SCROGHAM. Second by TAMMY GILBERT; Motion carried 4-0.
