The Fortville Town Council met Monday, May 17, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. at the Town Hall. The meeting was called to order by President, SEAN SIMMONS. Those present or absent:

Council Present: SEAN SIMMONS, PHIL SCROGHAM, JEFF RATLIFF, RON STAFFORD and TAMMY GILBERT

A Motion was made by JEFF RATLIFF to recess the council meeting for a public hearing regarding Ash Street. Second by RON STAFFORD; Motion carried 5-0.

A Motion to pass Ordinance 2010-4A, an Ordinance to Vacate a Public Way by PHIL SCROGHAM. Second by RON STAFFORD; Motion carried 4-1 (GILBERT-nay)

Council discussed the IDEM required lab testing fees for the water permit and this will be on the June 21, 2010, agenda.

A Motion was made to pass on second reading Ordinance 2010-5A, An Ordinance Regarding the Operation of Non-Traditional Vehicles on the Public Ways of the Town of Fortville, Indiana by PHIL SCROGHAM. Second by JEFF RATLIFF; Motion carried 3-2. (SIMMONS, STAFFORD-nay)
