

# POLICE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

The Police Board of Commissions held a meeting April 17, 2017 at the Fortville Town Hall. The meeting was called to order at 6:05 p.m. by President Pat Calhoun.

**Old Business:** Chief Knauer reports that the new radios are installed and working. Major Shelley has graduated from the FBI Academy and was second in his class.

**New Business:** Chief Knauer: Two new Ford patrol cars were ordered and will come in about 12 weeks. Cost is \$56,000.00 plus outfitting cost, fuel funds of \$16,000.00 was removed from that account to help pay the cost of cars.

Vehicle use: officers are asked to keep miles on patrol cars under 2,500 miles per month to save fuel.

Major Bratton has applied for the FBI Academy and will be in the October class if all security checks come back in time.

Guardian Tracking Software is a new tool the FPD will be using to track police work. It will log praises, awards, absenteeism and complaints. This will also be a tool for performance appraisals. These items will be recorded into officer's personal files.

Time Keeping: A system called Paychecks is being used by the town. This will give FPD a more accurate payroll system.

Reserves: The revolving door continues. The Chief sees at least three officers leaving to accept full employment at other departments.

Coffee with a Cop: Will be held at Lincoln Square Pancake House on May 6, 2017 from 8-10 am.

Adjourn: Motion by Bob Sterrett, second by Frank Caudill @ 6:48pm. APPROVED: 4-0.


